Greetings from Team NaaViC,

Innovative agri-business enterprises are increasingly embracing emerging technologies like artificial intelligence, machine learning and data analytics in addressing inherent intricacies of agriculture and allied sector especially in post COVID-19 pandemic time. 'Aatmanirbhar Bharat' or 'Self-reliant-India' mission aimed to support such local entrepreneurs with innovation. Agri-India Hackathon-2021, India's largest online Agriculture event, was one of such event initiated by Ministry of Agriculture and Farmers welfare. NaaViC actively joined hands in promoting Agri-India Hackathon-2021 through various digital/physical platforms, wherein two incubates of NaaViC won National prize competing with >7000 innovative agri-business proposals from pan India.

In addition, NaaViC released first tranche of Grant-in-aid to the winners of First Cohort entrepreneurs following physical verification and signing of MoUs. Further, NaaViC received several business proposals (>400) in Second & Third Cohort call for proposals under NEO and NEST programmes, which were screened by expert committee members during RIC meetings before recommending to grant-in-aid support. Virtual Two-month Agripreneurship training programmes for 2nd and 3rd Cohort entrepreneurs were carried out successfully in two batches.

On a path to excellence and sustainability of NaaViC, several noteworthy roadmap suggestions were provided by experts during first ABI-advisory Committee meeting. In addition to ongoing programmes, NaaViC also received funding from Department of Science and Technology (DST) for organizing National level Technology based Entrepreneurship Development Programme. In order to motivate young entrepreneurs, NaaViC organized programmes like 'Veterinary Entrepreneurship Orientation programme' and Demo day during Kisan Diwas / International Women day as well as series of Webinars on diverse topics of agriculture and allied sector.

As we look forward to receive innovative/disruptive business proposals in agriculture & allied sector, a call for 4th Cohort entrepreneurs is currently open. Team NaaViC encourages and supports inspired entrepreneurs to work towards realizing the mission of 'Aatmanirbhar Bharat'.






